- **MACC response to Eyjafjallajökull eruption.** MACC has been providing [daily forecasts](#) of the volcanic ash plume extent and is assessing the use of data assimilation to improve these forecasts.
- **MACC 2003 – 2010 reanalysis started.** The global MACC reanalysis for greenhouse gases, reactive gases, and aerosol started in March 2010 and will continue for the duration of the project. [Monthly mean plots](#) are available on the MACC site.
- **MACC support for HIPPO-3 aircraft campaign.** The MACC Observational Field Campaign Service provided automatic production and dissemination of ozone, carbon monoxide, and aerosol [forecast plots](#).
- **New MACC web server for Regional Air Quality.** Meteo France is the new host of the [Regional Air Quality web services](#).
- **Second MACC Assembly to be held in Toulouse from 18 – 22 October 2010.** Meteo France will host the [2nd MACC Assembly](#) from 18 – 22 October 2010. This Assembly will focus on internal project progress and planning.
